

DISPENSARY PRICE LIST (Make Your Own Range)

At Woodland Herbs we offer a wide range of recipes, ingredients and advice to let people make their own natural skincare, haircare or other natural cosmetics. This price list covers the majority of the base ingredients we stock, however please ask if there is anything else you would like.

There are 2 main options to make your own skincare. 1) by using **individual raw ingredients** you have total control of what goes into your products. It may be a bit more effort than buying a finished product or using a base product but it can be fun! 2) **base products**, whether lotions, creams, shampoos or other cosmetics can be used to add your choice of essential oils, vegetable oils, infused oil, herbal teas, tinctures or other ingredients. Typically these bases contain enough preservatives to give a good shelf life.

Once you know what you would like to do you will need a basic recipe that you can modify, adjust or develop to suit your needs. Some example recipes are:-

- ***Shampoo/conditioner for Dry Dark hair***; Base shampoo/conditioner plus Palamrosa essential oil, jojoba oil and rosemary essential oils.
- ***Shampoo/conditioner for Fair Oily Fine Hair***, Base shampoo/conditioner plus geranium, cedarwood and roman chamomile essential oils.
- ***Face mask for Oily Skin***; Green Clay 25g, Witch Hazel Water 10ml, Lavender oil 2 drops, Aloe vera gel 20ml. Apply for 10 minutes, avoiding the eye area.
- ***Gentle skin cleanser***; you could try Sweet almond oil on its own using damp cloth to wipe it off.
- ***Skin conditioning cream for oily skin from raw ingredients*** could be; water (or herbal infusion) 50ml, Oil (e.g. Sweet almond oil) 50ml, Beeswax (emulsifier) 15g, Bergamot and lavender essential oils 10 drops total. Needs to be kept in the fridge.
- ***Skin conditioning oil for dry inflamed skin***. Sweet almond oil 30ml, Rosehip oil 10ml, Jojoba oil 10ml, apply to cleansed skin.
- ***Stretch mark oil***. Wheatgerm oil 20ml, Sweet almond oil 30ml, massage into marks often.

This is just an example of possible recipes, the choices are endless, and should hopefully be fun to try. Please let us know your favourites and we will include them in our recipe book

All of our bases are formulated so that essential oils can be added to them directly and easily mixed into finished products. Itemised ingredients listings are given above. The majority of these products are water and vegetable oil based and can be extended with distilled water to obtain the required consistency. The ingredients used are considered environmentally friendly, mild and not tested on animals.

Glossary / ingredients

A glossary of the main ingredients is given on our website. Some useful items are:

Emollient: Any substance that prevents water loss from the skin. Most natural oils perform this function.

Emulsifier: A substance that holds oil in water or water in oil. Necessary in the manufacture of cream and lotions.

Fixed Oil: A fixed oil is chemically the same as a fat, but is generally liquid ie. Almond oil, grapeseed oil.

Glycerin (vegetable): A humectant and emollient, it absorbs moisture from the air, keeping moisture in your skin.

Lecithin: Natural antioxidant and emollient.. A stabiliser and emulsifier from soya beans, corn, peanuts and egg-yolk.
